



**HIP DYSPLASIA AND ELBOW DISEASE SCHEME—COVER SHEET**

***HOW TO LABEL THE X-RAYS***

The following information must be recorded on the radiograph:  
(stick on labels are not acceptable)

- Registered Name of the Dog (Pet name is not acceptable)
- Tattoo or microchip number
- Date the x-ray is taken
- Right and Left marker
- Registration number (Optional)

It is important that owners draw their Veterinarians attention to the radiograph identification requirements as detailed above. Failure to have the radiograph correctly identified with tattoo or microchip number will result in the results not being accepted.

***THE FOLLOWING DETAILS MUST BE COMPLETED ON THE FORM PROIR TO ISSUE:***

- Registration of the dog \*Registration number of the Dog \*Tattoo or microchip number
- Date of birth \*Sex of the dog \*Date the x-ray is taken
- 2 Generation pedigree \* The owners details \*Email address for owner

Owners are to ensure the Veterinarian completes and signs the relevant section and checks the tattoo or microchip number against the number appearing on the form.

***WHERE TO SEND THE RADIOGRAPH***

The NRCA continues to recommend Dr R Whyburn a the reader for the scheme.
